ORDER

S.R.O.1185(I)/2006.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Federal Government is pleased to direct that the following further amendment shall be made in the Export Policy Order, 2006, namely :-

In the aforesaid Order, in paragraph 8 in sub-paragraph (2) in clause (d) for the proviso the following shall be substituted, namely: -

“Provided that export made to International Security Assistance Force (ISAF) and Defence Energy Support Center (DESC), may be made on deferred payment basis, without opening of letters of credit, subject to the following conditions, namely: -

- (a) the waiver shall be applicable strictly to exports made to ISAF and DESC;
- (b) shipments to ISAF & DESC are made by their authorized agents duly endorsed by the ISAF and DESC receiving agent in Afghanistan; and
- (c) payment of foreign exchange is received within sixty days of shipment”.
