2019/20 Chevening Scholarships available: Application window opens soon for UK Government's prestigious global Master's Programme

Chevening Scholarships are the UK government's global education programme, funded by the Foreign and Commonwealth Office and partner organisations. The scholarship offers an opportunity for mid career professionals who want to study a one-year Master's degree at any of the UK's leading universities. The scholarships are awarded to outstanding individuals across a wide range of fields. It is aimed at people who could go to be future leaders of Pakistan.

The programme provides a unique opportunity for these future leaders to build a global network of professional significance and also to establish social, cultural, academic or commercial partnerships with the UK.

Applications for the Chevening Scholarship Programme must be submitted online at www.chevening.org and the deadline for receipt of applications is **12:00 GMT on 6th November 2018**. Applications received after this date will not be processed.
