SUBJECT: ONLINE TRAINING WORKSHOP ON "REPORT WRITING SKILLS FOR DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS", FROM AUGUST 24-26, 2020.

Akhtar Hameed Khan National Centre for Rural Development (AHKNCRD), an Attached Department of Establishment Division, is responsible for promoting the cause of rural development and poverty alleviation in Pakistan through its programmes of training and research. An online training mechanism would be utilized to impart the training sessions, which will be electronically accessible from home/office/any other place in order to attend the sessions. To attend the training programme, the participants need to have computer/mobile phone (Android/IOS) with internet connection and headphone. Two-one-hour sessions will be held on daily basis. E-Certificates will be awarded to the participants after completion of the programme.
- 5. It will be appreciated if nominations of 4-5 suitable officers from your department/organization are sent to NCRD by 21st August, 2020. The nomination letter is required to include: Name, Designation, Department, Contact no., & Email Address of the nominees. The coordinator may be contacted in case of any further queries.
