## OFFICE MEMORANDUM

## SUBJECT: PROHIBITION/COMPLETE QUANTITATIVE RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORT OF NON-ESSENTIAL AND LUXURY ITEMS

Pursuant to the decision of the Federal Cabinet in Case No. 180/21/2022 dated 15<sup>th</sup> July, 2022, I am directed to state that the Federal Government, in terms of paragraph 20 of the Import Policy Order, 2022 has been pleased to allow release of all those consignments/shipments which had been imported in violation of the SRO 598(I)/2022 dated 19<sup>th</sup> May, 2022 and are pending Customs Clearance, provided the consignment(s) had landed at any port including sea, air or dry port of the country on or before 30<sup>th</sup> June 2022, subject to payment of surcharge to be imposed on the C&F value of goods at the following rates:

Arrival of Shipments	Rate of Surcharge
For the shipments which had arrived within two weeks of issuance of the SRO 598(I)/2022 dated 19 <sup>th</sup> May 2022.	Five (5) percent
For the shipments which had arrived after two weeks of issuance of SRO 598(I)/2022 dated 19 <sup>th</sup> May 2022 till 30 <sup>th</sup> June, 2022.	Fifteen (15) percent.
