## **OFFICE MEMORANDUM**

SUBJECT: PROHIBITION/COMPLETE QUANTITATIVE RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORT OF NON-ESSENTIAL AND LUXURY ITEMS

This is in continuation of this Division's earlier O.M of even number dated 19<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 on the subject cited above.

2. In pursuance of the decision of the Federal Cabinet in Case No. 381/Rule-19/2022 dated 22-08-2022, I am directed to state that the Federal Government, in terms of paragraph 20 of the Import Policy Order, 2022 has been pleased to allow release of all those consignments of Auto CBU, Mobile Phones CBU and Home Appliances CBU, which have been imported in violation of the SRO 598(I)/2022 dated 19<sup>th</sup> May 2022 and have landed at any Pakistani port on or after 1<sup>st</sup> August, 2022 till 18<sup>th</sup> August, 2022 subject to payment of 100% surcharge on assessed value of the goods.
