The undersigned is directed to inform that the Government of Singapore has invited (2) two nominations for the above training course. - Permanent Government Officers (BS-17 and above) only and nominated by respective Federal Government or Provincial Department.
- Mid-to-senior level government officials involved in developing the digital economy in their country;
- Nominated by their respective Governments;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.

Objective: -

- Understand trends and challenges in AI and data governance.
- Gain an overview of cross-border data transfer tools.
- Identify effective strategies for the creation, protection and enforcement of Digital Economy centric IP rights.
- Learn about Singapore's and Japan's respective approaches towards AI and data governance.
