The undersigned is directed to inform that the Government of Singapore has invited one (01) nomination for the above **partially funded** training course. The Government of Singapore will bear local hospitality (accommodation and local transfers), training fees, training allowance and group personal accident/hospitalization insurance. The round-trip airfare for participants will have to be borne by the nominating Ministry or Provincial Department.

2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

**Eligibility Criteria: -**

- Permanent Government Officers (BS-17 and above) only and nominated by respective Federal Government or Provincial Department.
- Mid- to senior-level government officials involved in infrastructure project, planning and management;
- Nominated by their respective governments;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.

**Objective: -**

- PPP project development cycle – economic evaluation, costs and benefits; procurement and competitive tender criteria; financing model and risk assessment; and contract management
- Effective regulations and enabling legislation
- Pros and cons of the PPP approach
- Singapore's policies and regulatory frameworks for PPP developments
