

It is hoped that the Master Degree programme being offered by Yeungnam University, will be found useful and the esteemed Government would encourage a suitable young graduate official to pursue the Master's programme.

The programme is covered under the fellowship to be provided by the PSPS, Yeungnam University, R. O. Korea. While the admission and tuition fee and monthly living allowances for 12 months would be covered under the fellowship of the University, AARDO would meet the cost of two way air tickets of the selected candidates to travel to Korea and back to their respective countries. During the first three semesters, students will be required to remain on campus to complete their coursework. 

- **Foreign nationals**, or overseas Koreans who have completed primary and secondary education and obtained a bachelor's degree in a foreign country
- A **bachelor's degree** from an accredited college or university equivalent to a four-year Korean bachelor's degree
- High level of proficiency in **English**
- Applicants for the Forest and Environmental Policy major should have a Bachelor's Degree in the field of Agriculture, Forestry, Environmental areas
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally, to complete the program – Pregnancy is regarded as a disqualifying condition for participation in this program. Having Tuberculosis or any kind of contagious disease is regarded as a disqualifying condition for participation in this program.

Those who do not meet the requirements indicated above may still be considered for admission, subject to decision by the PSPS admission committee.
