2. The eligibility criteria for the above Master's Programme are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

- Be Permanent Government Officer (BS-17 & Above) only and nominated by respective Federal Government or Provincial Department having minimum of 2 years of experience in ICT policy in different areas.
- Have completed Bachelor Degree or an equivalent to college/university -level educational background.
- Have a good command of both spoken and written English in order to take classes conducted entirely in English and to be able to write academic reports and thesis in English.
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally, Pregnancy, HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis or any kinds of contagious disease are regarded as a disqualifying condition for the program.
- Be under age 40 as of February 1<sup>st</sup> 2019 (Preferable)

Objective:

- To help governmental officials of developing countries who are engaging in planning, implementation and evaluation of ICT policies enhance their comprehensive competency.
- To help them strengthen capabilities of implementing global cooperative projects with other partners through the advanced ICT and iCT convergence- related policies.
- To share the Korean experience in e-Government, ICT convergence and its application to other areas, as well as to produce leaders amicable to Korea
