
ORDER

S.R.O. 1625(I)/2019. - In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Federal Government is pleased to direct that in the Import Policy Order, 2016, the following further amendment shall be made and shall be deemed to have been so made from the 15th January, 2019, namely:-

In the aforesaid Order, in Appendix-E, in paragraph 3, in sub-paragraph (5), in clause (b), for full stop at the end, a colon shall be substituted and thereafter the following proviso shall be added, namely:-

“Provided that in case the Pak Rupee depreciates or government increases the import duties or taxes after receipt of remittance and before filing of the goods declaration, which results in shortfall of remitted amount against payable duties and taxes, the importer shall be allowed to meet the shortfall through local sources.”.
