SUBJECT: FIVE DAYS' TRAINING COURSE ON "SOCIAL ACCOUNTABILITY FOR EMPOWERMENT OF LOCAL COMMUNITY", MARCH 15-19, 2021.

Akhtar Hameed Khan National Centre for Rural Development (AHKNCRD), an Executive Department of Establishment Division, is responsible for promoting the cause of rural development in Pakistan through its programmes of training and research. Training is imparted, inter alia to officials of the Local Government and Rural Development Departments, elected representatives, functionaries of Nation Building Departments including NGO's in order to improve their professional skills and promote sharing of experiences regarding rural development in Pakistan.

2 AHKNCRD plans to organize a five days training course on "Social Accountability for Empowerment of Local Community", from 15-19 March, 2021. The major objectives of the training course are;

- To have an overview of the accountability in the country and discuss issues being faced;
- To discuss concept and approaches of Social Accountability as tools for empowerment of a community;
- To provide a forum for experience sharing with regard to social accountability and community empowerment amongst the participants at different parts of the country.

3 **No training fee will be charged for the training**, however, TA/DA of the participants shall be borne by the nominating agencies. Boarding and lodging facilities are available in the NCRD Hostel located within NCRD Complex, on the approved rates on double occupancy basis. Food expenses will be borne by the participants and staff is available in the Hostel for necessary services.

4. **Participants may please be informed that Family Members/Servants are not allowed to stay with them in the Hostel.**
