**SUBJECT: FIVE DAYS' TRAINING COURSE ON "MANAGEMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (LAND, WATER AND FOREST) FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT", FROM 06-10 DECEMBER, 2021.**

Akhtar Hameed Khan National Centre for Rural Development (AHKNCRD) an Executive Department of the Establishment Division, responsible for promoting the cause of rural development in Pakistan through its programmes of training research. Training is imparted, inter alia, to officials of the Local Government and Rural Development Departments, elected representatives, functionaries of Nation Building Departments including NGO's in order to improve their professional skills and promote sharing of experiences regarding rural development in Pakistan.

2. AHKNCRD plans to organize a five days training course on "MANAGEMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES (LAND, WATER AND FOREST) FOR SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT", from 06-10 DECEMBER, 2021. The major objectives of the training course are:

- To have an overview of the Natural Resources in the country and discuss their potential in development.
- To discuss concept and approaches of Natural Resources Management.
- To familiarize the participants with biodiversity, land, water & forest issues in Pakistan.
- To provide a forum for experience sharing with regard to NRM amongst the participants from different parts of the country.

No training fee will be charged for the training; however, TA/DA of the participants shall be borne by the nominating agencies. Boarding and lodging facilities are available in the NCRD Hostel located within NCRD Complex, on the approved rates on double occupancy basis. Food expenses will be borne by the participants and staff available in the hostel for necessary services.

4. Participants may please be informed that family members/servants are not allowed to stay with them in the Hostel.

5. It will be appreciated if nominations of 3-4 suitable officers from your department/organization are sent to NCRD by November, 29<sup>th</sup> 2021. The nomination letter is required to include.
