

OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: PROHIBITION/COMPLETE QUANTITATIVE RESTRICTIONS ON IMPORT OF NON-ESSENTIAL AND LUXURY ITEMS

Pursuant to the decision of the Federal Cabinet in Case No. 372/R-19/2022 dated 19th August, 2022, I am directed to state that the Federal Government, in terms of paragraph 20 of the Import Policy Order, 2022 has been pleased to allow release of all those consignments/shipments which have been imported in violation of the SRO 598(I)/2022 dated 19th May 2022 and landed at any Pakistani port, subject to payment of surcharge, as per the following details:

- i. To release those held up consignments, except Auto CBU, Mobile Phones CBU and Home Appliances CBU, which landed after 30th June 2022 and on or before 31st July 2022 subject to payment of 25% surcharge, and 35% surcharge for those consignments which arrived after 31st July 2022;
- ii. To release held up consignments of Auto CBU, Mobile Phones CBU and Home Appliances CBU which landed after 30th June 2022 and on or before 31st July 2022 subject to payment of 100% surcharge; and
- iii. The surcharge referred at Sr. Nos. i. and ii. above shall be imposed on assessed value of the goods.
