**SUBJECT: FIVE DAYS' TRAINING COURSE ON "LIVESTOCK MANAGEMENT FOR POVERTY ALLEVIATION": JANUARY 02-06, 2023.**

Akhtar Hameed Khan National Centre for Rural Development (AHKNCRD), an Executive Department of Establishment Division, is responsible for promoting the cause of rural development in Pakistan through its programmes of training and research. Training is imparted, inter alia to officials of the Local Government and Rural Development Departments, elected representatives, functionaries of Nation Building Departments in order to improve their professional skills and promote sharing of experiences regarding rural development in Pakistan.

2. AHKNCRD is planning to organize a five days' training course on "Livestock Management for Poverty Alleviation" from January 02-06, 2023. The major objectives of the training programme include:

- To learn the linkage between livestock management and poverty alleviation;
- To familiarize participants with the policies and initiatives taken by the Government for promotion of livestock sector in Pakistan;
- To discuss various issues and their solutions related to livestock management; and
- To promote sharing of relevant experiences with respect to livestock management.

No training fee will be charged for the training; however, TA/DA of the participants shall be borne by the nominating agencies. Boarding and lodging facilities are available in the NCRD Hostel located within NCRD Complex, on the approved rates on double occupancy basis. Food expenses will be borne by the participants and staff is available in the Hostel for necessary services.

4. Participants may please be informed that Family Members/Servants are not allowed to stay with them in the Hostel.
