Akhtar Hameed Khan National Centre for Rural Development (AHKNCRD), an Executive Department of Establishment Division, is responsible for promoting the cause of rural development in Pakistan through its programmes of training and research. Training is imparted, inter alia to officials of the Local Government and Rural Development Departments, elected representatives, functionaries of National Building Departments in order to improve their professional skills and promote sharing of experiences regarding rural development in Pakistan.

To attend the training programme, the participants need to have a computer/mobile phone (Android/IOS) with internet connection and headphone. Two one-hour sessions will be held on daily basis. E-Certificates will be awarded to the participants after completion of the programme.
