The undersigned is directed to inform that the Government of Singapore has invited nominations for the above Partially Funded training course. The Government of Singapore will bear local hospitality (accommodation and local transfers), course fees, training allowance and group personal accident/hospitalization insurance. The cost of round-trip airfare for the participants would be borne by the nominating agency/nominee himself/herself. The brochure of the subject training course is available at www.ead.gov.pk.

The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under: Eligibility Criteria:-

- Be permanent Government employees (BS-17 and above) nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Mid- to senior-level government officials who are involved in integrated waste management, environmental conservation and sustainability;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.

Objective:-

- This course will cover the principles of carbon accounting, focusing on methodologies to accurately account for carbon credits in compliance with Article 6 of the Paris Agreement. It will also equip participants with the skills to perform corresponding adjustments, ensuring transparency and preventing double-counting of mitigation outcomes.
- Nomination of suitable candidates duly approved by the competent authority along with the following documents may kindly be forwarded to this Ministry latest by 23rd May, 2025 positively. Interested officers are requested to apply online at https://go.gov.sg/carbonaccounting2025 as required by Singapore (Mandatory). Nomination without online application will not be considered by the host.
