The undersigned is directed to inform that the Government of Singapore has invited nominations for the above <u>Partially Funded</u> training course. The Government of Singapore will bear local hospitality (accommodation and local transfers), course fees, training allowance and group personal accident/hospitalization insurance. The cost of round-trip airfare for the participants would be borne by the nominating agency/nominee himself/herself. 2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under: **Eligibility Criteria:**-

- Be permanent government employee (BS-17 or above) nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Mid- to senior-level government officials involved in policymaking for sustainability and the environment.;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.

Objective:-

- This course will provide an overview of green financing, emphasising the role of financial instruments and policy frameworks in supporting environmentally sustainable projects. It will also explore mechanisms to mobilise capital for green initiatives and assess associated risks.

Nomination of suitable candidates duly approved by the competent authority along with the following documents may kindly be forwarded to this Ministry latest by <u>28th July, 2025</u> positively. Interested officers are requested to apply online at https://go.gov.sg/greenfinancing2025 as required by Singapore (Mandatory). Nomination without online application will not be considered by the host.
