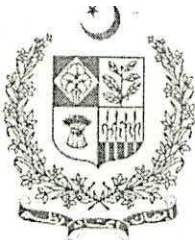

**SUBJECT: FIVE DAYS' TRAINING COURSE ON "MANAGING WATER RESOURCES: CHALLENGES AND SOLUTIONS", 19<sup>th</sup> - 23<sup>th</sup> MAY, 2025.**

Akhtar Hameed Khan National Centre for Rural Development (AHKNCRD), an Attached Department of Establishment Division, is responsible for promoting the cause of rural development in Pakistan through its programmes of training and research. Training is imparted, inter alia to officials of the Local Government and Rural Development Departments, elected representatives, functionaries of Nation Building Departments including NGO's in order to improve their professional skills and promote sharing of experiences regarding rural development in Pakistan.

2. AHKNCRD plans to organize a five days training course on "**Managing Water Resources: Challenges and Solutions**", from **19<sup>th</sup> - 23<sup>th</sup> May, 2025**. The major objectives of the training course are;

- To examine overall perspective of water resource in the country and discuss major issues in management of water resource at national level;
- To devise means in resolving the obstacles being faced and government policies and strategies with regard to water resource management;
- To promote sharing of experiences among participants on issues related to water resources.

3. **No training fee will be charged for the training**, however, TA/DA of the participants shall be borne by the nominating agencies. Boarding and lodging facilities are available in the NCRD Hostel located within NCRD Complex, on the approved rates on double occupancy basis. Food expenses will be borne by the participants and staff is available in the Hostel for necessary services.

4. **Participants may please be informed that Family Members/Servants are not allowed to stay with them in the Hostel.**
