ORDER

S.R.O. 750(I)/2025.- In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 of the Imports & Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Federal Government is pleased to prohibit the following, in the interest of national security and in public interest, namely: -

- (i) The import of Indian origin goods by third countries via sea, land and air; transiting through Pakistan;
- (ii) Goods imported from India by third countries via sea, land and air; transiting through Pakistan;
- (iii) The exports of third countries, to India via sea, land and air; transiting through Pakistan; and;
- (iv) The above-mentioned prohibitions shall not be applicable to those imports/exports for which the Bill of Lading (B/L) or Letter of Credit (L/C) is issued or established prior to the issuance of the Order.
