OFFICE MEMORANDUM

SUBJECT: CLARIFICATION REGARDING RE-DETERMINATION OF INTER-SE-SENIORITY OF OFFICERS OF COMMERCE AND TRADE GROUP

The undersigned is directed to refer to Ministry of Commerce's D.O letter <u>dated 21-05-2025</u> on the subject and to state that the inter-se-seniority of the probationers of Occupational Groups and Services is to be decided under Rule 6(2) read with Rule 7(4) of the Occupational Groups, Services (Probation, Training & Seniority) Rules, 1990, as amended from time to time.

- 2. It is further clarified that the cadre administrator i.e. M/o Commerce while formulating inter-se-seniority list of CTG officers had to determine the inter-se-seniority keeping in view the following criteria, as ascribed in the ibid Rules and its amendments-
 - (i) Marks obtained in the Competitive Examination of FPSC or notional marks
 - (ii) Marks obtained in the initial training program (CTP) or notional marks
 - (iii) Marks obtained in the Specialized program (STP)
- (iv) Marks obtained by qualifying in Final Passing Out Examination in the first attempt (marks of failed subject will be minus in light of clause c of OM dated 23-09-2015)
- (v) If probationer fails in second attempt of FPOE, his inter-se-seniority will be fixed at the bottom of the batch.
- (vi) If a probationer is granted deferment from CTP, his/ her inter-se-seniority will be fixed with the batch he/ she undergoes/ completes the CTP.
 - M/o Commerce may take further action accordingly, please.
