2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the subject course are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

- Be Permanent Government employee (BS-17 and above) nominated by the respective Federal Ministry or Provincial Department.
- Mid- to senior-level government officials who are involved in urban development projects;
- Proficient in written and spoken English; and
- In good health.

Objective

- This course is conducted under the auspices of the Japan-Singapore Partnership Programme for the 21st Century (JSPP21). The course will explore the opportunities and challenges arising from artificial intelligence (AI) and big data in the digital economy. It aims to equip government officials with an innovative mindset to develop effective AI and data governance frameworks that protect privacy and intellectual property while maximizing economic benefits.

3. Nomination of suitable candidates duly approved by the competent authority along with the following documents may kindly be forwarded to this Ministry latest by **November 12, 2025** positively.
