SUBJECT: RECRUITMENT FOR THE HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM (JDS)-2025 IN PAKISTAN.

The undersigned is directed to refer to the subject and inform that the Government of Japan has announced Human Resource Development Scholarship Program (JDS)-2025 for young capable federal government officers to pursue sixteen Master's Degree (Two years) and one Doctoral Degree (Three Years) programs in different universities of Japan. The aim of scholarship program is to strengthen the administrative capacities of Civil Servants/Ex-Cadre Officers of federal government of Pakistan and enable them to contribute to the socioeconomic development of the country.

2. The Japan International Cooperation Center (JICE) will provide the services to execute this program. JICE has now circulated this facility for Master's and Doctoral degrees for Academic year starting from 2026 and researches at designated Japanese universities. - Be Cadre officers of occupational groups (CSS) / Ex-Cadre Officer of the Federal Government of Pakistan in BPS 17 and above (Except Corporate body & Autonomous Body).
- Have at least 3 years of work experience including period of probation after entering public service at the time of application deadline.
- Have a good command of both written and spoken English. iii.
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally to participate in the program in Japan. iv.
- Not currently availing any other foreign scholarship simultaneously. ٧.
- Not be military personnel. vi.
- Have not obtained Master's or higher degrees overseas under support of foreign scholarship vii. programs (for Master's Degree candidates).
- Have not obtained Doctoral degree overseas under support of foreign scholarship programs viii. (for PhD candidates).

- Be between 25 and 40 years as of April 1st, 2026. i.
- Possess a bachelor degree authorized by the Government of Pakistan or other countries. ii.

Eligibility for PhD Program:

The applicant should:

- i. Be between 25 and 45 years as of April 1st, 2026.
- ii. Have Master's Degree issued from Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) Countries university.
- Have published at least one peer-reviewed article (published in internationally recognized iii. academic journals).
- Have a letter of recommendation from an academic advisor is required for acceptance into a iv. doctoral program, most applicants are contacting the professors who supervised them during their JDS master's studies.
- All Ministries/Divisions/ Departments are requested to circulate the subject facility in their 3. respective organizations and direct the suitable federal government officers to apply on given JICE's website: https://jds-sholarship.org/ and also send nominations along-with copy of prescribed JDS Application form, original surety bond, undertaking, CNIC and valid Passport to the undersigned latest by 05-12-2025.
