## Requirement of Documents

An applicant shall first of all obtain a **recommendation** from a relevant government agency in his/her home country addressed to the Economic and Commercial Office of the Chinese Embassy regarding his/her program application. With a recommendation obtained, the applicant shall then prepare the following materials and submit them to the Economic and Commercial Office of the Chinese Embassy for an inspection.

1	Degrees	An original copy needs to be prepared for each degree with attestation by Higher Education Commission Pakistan.
2	Official Transcripts	Transcripts must list all courses taken and all scores obtained with attestation by Higher Education Commission Pakistan.
3	Personal Statement	Personal statement must be written in Chinese or English and be 600-800 words in length. It shall cover such essential elements as applicant's academic background, work experience, achievements, study purpose and future career plans.
4	CV	CV Should include, but not be limited to, contact information, rank or position, employer, and job title. Written in Chinese or English.
5	Recommendation Letters	Two letters: one letter must come from a professor (or at least an associate professor) of the previously enrolled university; the other must come from the current employer or supervisor;
6	English Language Proficiency Test Results	IELTS or TOEFL score report.
7	Physical Examination Form	A certified physical examination form issued within the last one month
8	Passport	All successful candidates must enter China and register with Zhejiang University using the same

		passport as used for applying for the program.
9	Non Crime Record Proof	Applicant shall obtain the proof from the relevant agency in his/her country, with attestation by Ministry of Foreign Affairs.
10	Written Request to ECO for a Recommendation Letter	The request should clearly state whether the applicant is willing to be considered for other programs if the applied program is already full.

# 全球发展学院博士项目

2026 年 9 月入学 | 紧急招募通知

### 一、背景信息

2025 年 11 月 22 日，中国国务院总理李强在约翰内斯堡二十国集团领导人第二十次峰会讲话中宣布：“中国将设立全球发展学院（Institute of Global Development），推动各国共同发展。”全球发展学院旨在促进共同繁荣、加强全球合作，并支持关于发展和治理的循证研究。

浙江大学（Zhejiang University, ZJU）是中国顶尖的研究型大学之一，受中国政府委托负责全球发展学院的建设，并从 2026 年 9 月起正式启动首批博士项目。

### 二、项目概述

全球发展学院将开设以下两个博士专业（共计 15 名/年）：

- 应用经济学博士
- 公共管理博士（侧重发展治理）

学制 3.5 年。所有博士生须在第一学年（约 10 个月）在中国完成课程学习与规定学分。在满足学分要求后，博士生可返回所在国家开展研究，并根据需要定期来华进行田野调查、调研、机构挂职或短期研究访问。

本项目提供全额奖学金，涵盖学费、住宿费、学业必需的往返国际旅费、在华期间的基本生活费和医疗保险费。

### 三、招生对象

本项目面向致力于发展、治理和全球合作的现任及未来领导者。学员以全球南方国家为主，兼顾北方国家。

符合条件的申请人包括：

- 政府部门：高级公务员，包括司级和处级干部；
- 高教机构：所在国家顶尖（前十位）大学的高层管理人员，原则上是校长或副校长，可适当放宽到院长或系主任以及高级职称教学人员；
- 商业部门：所在国家前 10 强公司的高级管理人员；
- 其他相关领域的优秀代表或具备潜力的青年人才。

### 四、语言要求

具备良好的英语能力：需满足雅思 6.5 分及以上或托福 100 分及以上。

# CALL FOR APPLICATIONS

## PhD Programs at the Institute of Global Development

### September 2026 Intake – Urgent Call for Applications

#### Background

On November 22, 2025, Chinese Premier LI Qiang announced in his address at the 20th G20 Summit in Johannesburg, South Africa, that “China will establish the Institute of Global Development to promote common development among all countries.” The Institute is intended to advance shared prosperity, strengthen global cooperation, and support evidence-based development governance.

Zhejiang University (ZJU), one of China’s leading research institutions, has been entrusted by the Chinese government with the establishment of the Institute of Global Development and will officially launch its inaugural PhD programs in September 2026.

#### Program Overview

The Institute of Global Development will begin with two doctoral majors (15 vacancies each year):

- PhD in Applied Economics

- PhD in Public Administration (with development-governance focus)

The program duration is 3.5 years. All students must take their classes in China for the first academic year (approximately 10 months) to complete coursework and required credits. After meeting the credit requirements, students may return to their home countries and come back to China periodically for field visits, surveys, institutional secondments, or short research stays. The program also welcomes outstanding representatives from related fields and promising young talents.

The program would offer a full scholarship, covering tuition fees, accommodation, round-trip international travel expenses essential for study, basic living expenses in China, and medical insurance.

### **Target Applicants**

The program is designed for current and future leaders committed to development, governance and global cooperation. Applicants may come from both the Global South as well as the Global North.

Eligible applicants include government-sector professionals, such as Director-level officials as well as Division Chief-level professionals; in

the academic sector, eligible applicants include senior management in the top universities of their respective countries (at least among the top 10<sup>th</sup>), such as School Deans or Vice Presidents of top universities, as well as senior academic or teaching staff in higher-education institutions; and in the business sector, eligible applicants include senior managers and executives from the top 10 companies in their respective countries.

### **Language Requirements**

- English proficiency required (IELTS 6.5+ or TOEFL 100+)

- Advanced training in development and governance, evidence-based policymaking, and comparative global development
- Exposure to cutting-edge research environments at Zhejiang University

## 全球发展学院简介

为推进联合国 2030 年可持续发展议程的落实，切实破解全球发展进程中的瓶颈性难题，有效凝聚多方智慧与力量，2025 年 11 月 22 日，中国国务院总理李强在约翰内斯堡二十国集团领导人第二十次峰会讲话中宣布：“中国将设立全球发展学院，推动各国共同发展。”

浙江大学作为中国顶尖高校，学术底蕴深厚、综合实力卓越，受中国政府委托负责全球发展学院的建设。学院使命为：以人才的力量、思想的力量，助力提升全球发展能力，推动各国共同发展。学院发展愿景为：建设集高水平学历教育、高层次人才培训和高质量学术研究于一体的新型创新性学院，打造世界领先的未来领军人才培养高地、全球发展研究重镇。

学院实行**实体化**运作，业务指导部门为国家商务部和教育部，由浙江大学国家战略与区域发展研究院牵头，联合浙江大学国际教育学院、经济学院和公共管理学院等共同举办。学院将依托浙江大学丰富的教育资源与专业优势、广泛的国际交流合作基础、多样化的人才培养模式与方法，以及浙江省丰富的创新创业实践，开展三个层面的工作：

**一是开展学历学位教育**，为全球可持续发展领域提供长期性、战略性人才支撑。依托“应用经济学”“公共管理学”两个一级学科，每年招收硕士、博士研究生 80 人，其中外籍学生主要以招收世界各国特别是“全球南方”国家精英群体为主，涵盖中高层政府官员、国际组织人才、知名企业中层等，努力培养具备全球视野、扎实专业素养与跨文化沟通能力的影响世界的未来领导者。

**二是开展非学历项目**，精准服务可持续发展领域的即时需求。学院将依托“中国—东盟数字经济研修班”“发展中国家反贫困问题高级研修班”等品牌项目，每年培训 300 人左右。并将与联合国相关机构、各国科研院校、国际公益组织等合作，紧扣联合国 2030 年议程核心目标与全球发展倡议重点领域，持续设计开发专题培训项目，激发和加强各方参与国际治理与全球发展的行动力和能力水平。

**三是建设全球发展领域世界级学术研究与政策研究重镇**，构建“基础研究+应用研究+成果转化”全链条创新平台。学院将聚焦全球发展倡议与 2030 后全球发展议程和全球发展重大议题开展研究，形成务实决策成果，为破解全球发展难题提供智力支撑。学院将发挥浙江大学在人工智能、数字经济等战略性领域的学科积淀与科研优势，通过共建联合实验室、技术转移中心等实体合作载体，推动成熟技术成果在目标国家落地转化，搭建政产学研高端对话平台。

## Institute of Global Development

On November 22, 2025, Chinese Premier LI Qiang announced in his address at the 20th G20 Summit in Johannesburg, South Africa, “China will establish the Institute of Global Development to promote common development among all countries.” This new initiative is to effectively pool the wisdom and resources of key stakeholders to facilitate the implementation of the UN 2030 agenda and to address the bottleneck issues in the process of global development. Zhejiang University (ZJU), a top university in China, has been entrusted by the Chinese government with the establishment of the Institute of Global Development

**Our mission is** to harness the power of talents and ideas to strengthen development capacities globally and promote common development among all nations.

**Our vision is** to establish a new, innovative institute to deliver **high-level degree courses** for mid- to senior-level government officials and executives from leading enterprises, **provides high-end talent training programs**, and **conducts high-quality academic studies**. The Institute aims to become a **world-leading platform for cultivating future leaders and a global hub for development research**.

The Institute is guided by the Ministry of Commerce and the Ministry of Education of the People's Republic of China. It is organized by the Institute for National Strategy and Regional Development, together with the College of International Education, the School of Economics, and the School of Public Affairs at Zhejiang University. Leveraging Zhejiang University's rich educational resources, strong academic foundations, extensive international exchange and cooperation network, and diverse approaches to talent development, as well as Zhejiang Province's rich practices in innovation and entrepreneurship, the Institute undertakes work in three major areas:

First, the Institute offers **high-level degree programs** under two first-level disciplines—“**Applied Economics**” and “**Public Administration**”—to cultivate talents with a long-term and strategic vision for global development. It admits 80 postgraduate students annually. A significant proportion of these students will be outstanding international students, primarily from the Global South, including government officials, staff members of international organizations, and executives of renowned companies. It is committed to cultivating future leaders with a global perspective, solid professional expertise, and

cross-cultural communication skills, and empowering them to contribute meaningfully to global development.

Second, the Institute provides **non-degree education programs** to respond precisely to immediate needs in the field of sustainable development. Building on its branded programs, such as the “ASEAN-China Digital Economy Workshop” and the “Advanced Seminar on Anti-Poverty Issues in Developing Countries,” the Institute will train approximately 300 participants each year. The Institute will also collaborate with relevant United Nations agencies, universities and research institutions, and other international organizations. Focusing on the core objectives of the United Nations 2030 Agenda and the priority areas of the Global Development Initiative, the Institute will continue to design and develop thematic training programs to strengthen participation, capacity, and action in international governance and global development.

Third, the Institute conducts **high-quality academic research** to establish a world-class academic and policy research hub for global development. It will be a full-chain innovation platform integrating basic research, applied research, and the commercialization of research outcomes. With a particular focus on the Global Development Initiative, the post-2030 global development agenda, and other major global development issues,

the Institute will produce practical insights to support decision-making and provide intellectual solutions to global development challenges. Furthermore, leveraging Zhejiang University's academic strengths and research capacity in AI, digital economy, and other related strategic areas, the Institute will promote the transfer of relevant technologies to developing countries through joint laboratories and technology transfer centers, while fostering high-level dialogue platforms engaging government, industry, and academia.
