- Not have participated in the same KOICA training program during the past three (3) years.

- Relieve gender inequality in the establishment and implementation of economic policies in the Asia-Pacific region.
- Enforcement of ability enhancement education targeted towards public officials for gender equal policy establishment in developing countries.
Hand down methods of practical policy establishments to developing countries through sharing the case of gender responsive budgeting of Korea.

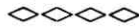
