

- Priority will be given to those applicants who have not been awarded any scholarship for a master's degree in a foreign country.

- 2) A monthly stipend determined in accordance with IDEAS regulations
- 3) Free tuition
- 4) Free textbooks
- 5) An individual locker, desk and computer with Internet access,
