- i) Be national of Countries eligible for the young leader program (school of local governance).
- ii) Be under 40 of age as at 1st October 2017.
- iii) Have a bachelor degree or equivalent from a recognized/ accredited university and have achieved shown excellent academic performance.
- iv) A minimum TOEFL iBT score of at least 79(TIEFL – BPT score of 550) ELETS 6.0 or equivalent.
- v) Be 3-years of work experience in public administration (preferably 5 years or more).
- vi) Be in good health both physically and mentally to participate in the program.
- vii) Have a command of spoken and written English.


Programme Objectives:
