The undersigned is directed to refer to Asian Development Bank's (ADB) letter dated Nil October, 2016 on the subject noted above (copy enclosed) and to say that Asian Development Bank Institute (ADBI) in collaboration with the Asian Keio University will conduct a one-week intensive executive training program on "**Contemporary Macroeconomic Policies in Globalized Economy**" on 28 November to 2 December, 2016 in Tokyo, Japan. This program aims to nurture future leaders from the public sector.

2. In today's highly integrated economy, where countries are faced with complex issues requiring evidence based decisions by policy makers, the need to equip future Government leaders with critical skills and tools to understand contemporary macroeconomic problems is crucial. By using a combined rigorous theoretical and empirical approach to analyzing macroeconomic issues, the program provides the participants with a deeper understanding of policy issues covering fiscal policy, monetary policy, exchange rate policy, capital flow management, financial sector regulation, and economic cooperation and integration. Throughout the course, the participants will have the opportunity not only to study the latest theoretical and empirical research in macroeconomic policy, but also to exchange views on how to implement effective policies and strategies in their countries. Eventually, we plan to bring together top policy makers around developing Asia and develop their capacity as leaders of the next generation.

3. The course will consist of cutting-edge lectures, intensive class discussions, independent and group work, as well as major presentations on selected country issues. Upon completion of course, a certificate will be granted by Keio University. A tentative Schedule is attached.
