- Be a nominated by his or her Government.
- Have sufficient command of both spoken and written English in order to take classes conducted entirely in English and to be able to write academic reports and theses in English.
- Possibly work in the international development field for at least one year after the completion of this MA programme.
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally, to under go the course.
- Pregnancy is regarded as disqualifying conditions for participating in this programme. *
 Having a tuberculosis or any kind of contagious disease is regarded as disqualifying conditions for participating in this programme.
- Have not previously received a scholarship, including KOICA scholarship programme, or any of its kind before.

- To explore sustainable development models in a comparative perspective.
- To build up the foundation for stronger diplomatic relationship and economic cooperation with developing countries.
