The undersigned is directed to say that the Government of Republic of Korea has invited nominations for the fully funded subject Master training programme starting from August 2012-December 2013. 2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the course are as under:

### Eligibility Criteria

- Be a government official or an employee in the public sector or a researcher in state institution with a Bachelor's Degree or higher. Private sector employees are not eligible. However, if the applicant works in a development non-governmental organization (NGO) or Un-associated organization, he/she can apply on the condition that he/she obtains a recommendation from the government ministry which covers the organization.
- Be nominated by his or her Government.
- Have sufficient command of both spoken and written English in order to take classes conducted entirely in English and to be able to write academic reports and theses in English.
- Should have a positive attitude and a strong will to get adjusted in a multicultural environment and to understand the hosting country's culture.
- Should have a good moral character.
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally.
- Pregnancy is regarded as a disqualifying condition for participation in this programme.
- Having Tuberculosis or any kind of contagious disease is regarded as a disqualifying condition for participation in this programme.

### **Objectives**

- To educate the leaders in developing countries with the extensive knowledge of society and the rural community specifically to effectively eradicate poverty and instill the strong "we can do it" mindset.
- To equip students with the capabilities of designing and implementation new policies and programmes which can brings socio-economic transformation in their countries and rural areas by analyzing and sharing Korea's development experiences.
- To educate the students with the scientific research methodology necessary to solve an array of problems existing in their government systems and rural communities.
