2. The eligibility criteria for the above Master's Programme are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

- Be a citizen of the Scholarship Program target country
- Be officially nominated by their government
- Be a government official or an employee in the public sector. Private sector employees
 are not eligible. However, if the applicant works in a development non-governmental
 organization (NGO) or UN-associated organization, he/she can apply on the condition
 that he/she obtains a recommendation from the government ministry which covers the
 organization.
- Be a university/college graduate or have an equivalent educational background.
- Be under 40 vrs age.
- Have sufficient command of both spoken and written English in order to take classes conducted entirely in English and to be able to write academic reports and theses in English.
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally.
- Not have had experience in any of the KOICA's Training courses within the past three
 years in the same field.
- A participant who has once withdrawn from the program due to a failure to attain certain grades, a violation of the rules of the training institute, or a false entry is not allowed to re-apply for Scholarship Program.

Objectives:

- To develop human resources that will contribute to the socio-economic advancement of developing countries –
- To train experts in the fields of International Development and Cooperation needed by the developing countries –
- To share Korea's economic development experience and train international development cooperation experts who can contribute to global economic development —
- To enhance the understanding on Korean industries and Korean corporate management system _

iii. How your education and work experience qualify you for admission to this program - Your contribution to the field of International Development & Cooperation and how KUGSIS-KOICA program will help you achieve your goals

iv. Future career path after completing this program

- Certificate of Degree (or Certificated Expected Graduation Form) of all colleges and graduate schools (should be written in English)
- 5) Official transcripts of all colleges and graduate schools (should be SEALED by the issuing institution and written in English)

6) A copy of passport

- 7) Two letters of recommendation from professors familiar with the applicant's academic work or from professional supervisors.
- 8) TOEFL, TOEIC, IELTS score report * Native speakers of English or those who graduated from the university which all courses are conducted in English are exempt from this requirement.

- 10) Curriculum Vitae (Optional)
- 11) KOICA Application Form (four Copies)
- 12) Foreign Training Committee Profarma (FTC)
- 13) National identity Card (NIC) Copy
- 14) Passport Copy
