The Seminar, will provide an introduction to the WTO system, including the economic and legal rationale behind its main disciplines and the relationship between the different WTO Agreements. The seminar will focus on the WTO as a forum for negotiations, and also cover the main key agreements namely agriculture, services and non-agricultural market access (NAMA) related agreements. A state of play for post-Bali negotiation will also be covered and the remaining issues of the Doha Development Agenda (DDA) in relation to further market openings.
