Subject: MASTER'S PROGRAMME ON INTERNATIONAL DEVELOPMENT POLICY
AUGUST, 2010 – SEPTEMBER, 2011, SEOUL, KOREA

The undersigned is directed to say that the Government of Republic of Korea has invited nominations for the above Master's Programme during the year 2010 – 2011. 2. The eligibility criteria and objectives of the course are as under:

Eligibility Criteria

The applicant should be:

- Be a citizen of the Scholarship Program target country.
- Be officially nominated by their government
- Be a government official or an employee in the public sector, Private sector employees are not eligible. However, if the applicant works in a development non-governmental organization (NGO) or Un-associated organization, he/she can apply on the condition that he/she obtains a recommendation from the government ministry which covers the organization.
- Be a university / college graduate or have an equivalent educational background.
- Have sufficient command of both spoken and written English in order to take classes conducted entirely in English and to be able to write academic reports and theses in English.
- Be in good health, both physically and mentally,
- Pregnancy, HIV/AIDS, tuberculosis or any kind of contagious disease is regarded as a disqualifying condition for the program.
- Have not previously received a scholarship from the Korean government.

Objectives

- To secure a pool of future international experts with professionalism and competence needed for international development cooperation.
- To contribute to the development of human resources who will positively and effectively contribute to the socio economic advancement of developing countries;
- To share the Korean experience and knowledge with other developing countries, which will enhance their ability to further their expertise in the areas of economic development and quality of life.


