# SUBJECT: NOMINATION FOR THE NEXT DIRECTOR GENERAL OF SOUTH ASIA CO-OPERATIVE ENVIRONMENT PROGRAMME (DG-SACEP) FROM GOVERNMENT OF PAKISTAN

Nominations of suitable Officers are invited for selection against the post of Director General South Asia Cooperative Environment Programme (DG-SACEP).

2. South Asia Co-operative Environment Programme (SACEP) is an intergovernmental organization, established in 1982 by the governments of South Asia to promote and support protection, management and enhancement of the environment in the region SACEP member countries are Afghanistan, Bangladesh, Bhutan, India, Maldives, Nepal, Pakistan and Sri Lanka. The post of DG-SACEP is filled from the member states on rotational and merit basis for a period of three years. Presently the post is held by Sri Lanka till April 2015.

Job description and required qualifications for the post are as follows:

### A. JOB DESCRIPTION:

- (i) The Director General, SACEP will be the head of the organization and provide leadership in the efficient and effective functioning of the organization and fulfillment of its mandate as contained in the Declaration and Articles of Association of SACEP and the decisions of the Meetings of the Governing Councils and the Consultative Committee of SACEP.
- (ii) In particular the incumbent will be responsible for:
  - · Overall administrative and financial control of the organization.
  - Programme planning, budgeting and resource mobilization, including fund-raising and co-financing.
  - Building and developing close relationships with the stakeholder bodies, including alliance partners and other organizations
  - Performing other functions and responsibilities entrusted by the Governing Council and its Committees.
  - Meeting the reporting requirements laid down by the Governing Council and the Consultative Committee.

### B. QUALIFICATONS:

- a) He / She should have an Advanced University Degree (Ph.D or Post Graduate qualification) in a relevant discipline (Social Science Natural Sciences Planning, Engineering Law, Business Management Environmental Management Environmental Economics)
- b) 15 years of professional experience of which at least 10 years be at a senior level with demonstrated planning, managerial and leadership capabilities and sound knowledge of environmental and sustainable development issues at the national regional and global levels
- e) Proven skill in identifying formulating planning operating and monitoring environmental programmes knowledge and experience at the procedures adopted by the UN Agencies and other technical or financial assistance agencies.
- d) Excellent communication skills
- Good interpersonal skills and the ability to work in a multi-cultural, multiethnic environment with sensitivity and respect for diversity
- Age 40-55 years.
- g) It would also be desirable for the Director General to have an established and good working relationship with governments of SACEP member and non-member countries, international and regional bodies, aide agencies relevant non-government organizations, senior management in private sector, corporations, companies and foundations etc.
- 4. As per policy of the Government of Pakistan, the selectee government servant shall be invariably treated as; "on deputation" for the period of assignment, after obtaining clearance of the Special Selection Board and approval of the competent authority (Chief Executive for Officer in BS-19 and above; Establishment Secretary for Officers BS-17 & 18), with the following conditions:
  - the deputation shall be made initially for a period equal to the approve tenure of appointment offered by the borrowing international agencies / foreign government(three years in this case);
  - Surety bond shall be executed by the concerned government servant, that
    he will revert to the parent government / department on completion of the
    approved tenure of deputation and in case of default he will render himself
    liable to Efficiency and Discipline proceedings for misconduct (unauthorized absence).
  - No government servant shall approach the international agency / foreign governments for seeking employment etc. directly;
  - The government servant proceeding on deputations, under the above referred policy guidelines, shall vacate the government allotted residential accommodation, as required extant rules.
