**ORDER**

S.R.O. 805 (I)/2015.- In exercise of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950), the Federal Government is pleased to direct that the following further amendments shall be made in the Export Policy Order, 2013, namely:-

In the aforesaid Order, in paragraph 7, before sub-paragraph (2), the following sub-paragraph shall be inserted, namely:-

“(1) **In Pak Rupees.**— (a) Subject to provisions of sub-paragraph (1) of paragraph-4, export of the following perishable goods shall only be allowed against Pak currency on filing of regular shipping bills without the requirement of E “Form, namely:-

- (i) fruits;
- (ii) vegetables;
- (iii) dairy products; and
- (iv) meat.


(b) Export of the items in clause (a) shall not be entitled to,

- (i) zero rating of sales tax on taxable goods;
- (ii) rebate of central excise duty; and
- (iii) payment of drawback of customs duty”.

2. This notification shall take effect from the first day of July, 2015.
