**PUBLIC NOTICE**

Subject: **EXPORT OF RICE**

**No.4 (2)/2008-E.I** In exercise of powers conferred vide Section 3 (1) of Imports and Exports (Control) Act, 1950 (XXXIX of 1950) and with reference to S.No 3, Schedule II of SRO. 1021 (I)/2007 dated October 8, 2007, it is hereby notified that export of rice from Pakistan shall be allowed subject to the following conditions: -

(a) The FOB value of consignments shall be above the Minimum Export Price (MEP) specified for the types as below: -

i. Super Basmati	US\$ 1,500/ MT
ii. Basmati	US\$ 1,300/MT
iii. IRRI- 6	US\$ 750/MT
iv. IRRI – 9 (Long Grain)	US\$ 1,000/MT

**Note:** MEP shall not be applicable on the export consignments for which irrevocable letters of credit are established *before* April 30, 2008.

(b) All export consignments shall be accompanied by a certificate of quality and specifications by Quality Review Committee of Trade Development Authority of Pakistan.
